4. Corporate donations will be accepted by cheque at any of the above locations.

The conceptual plan for Realtors Park will enhance existing space with improvements to landscaping, seating and shade. The conceptual plan illustrates areas for cricket batting cages, outdoor fitness, expanded tennis courts and multi-purpose space. An area for youth interactive play is also contemplated.

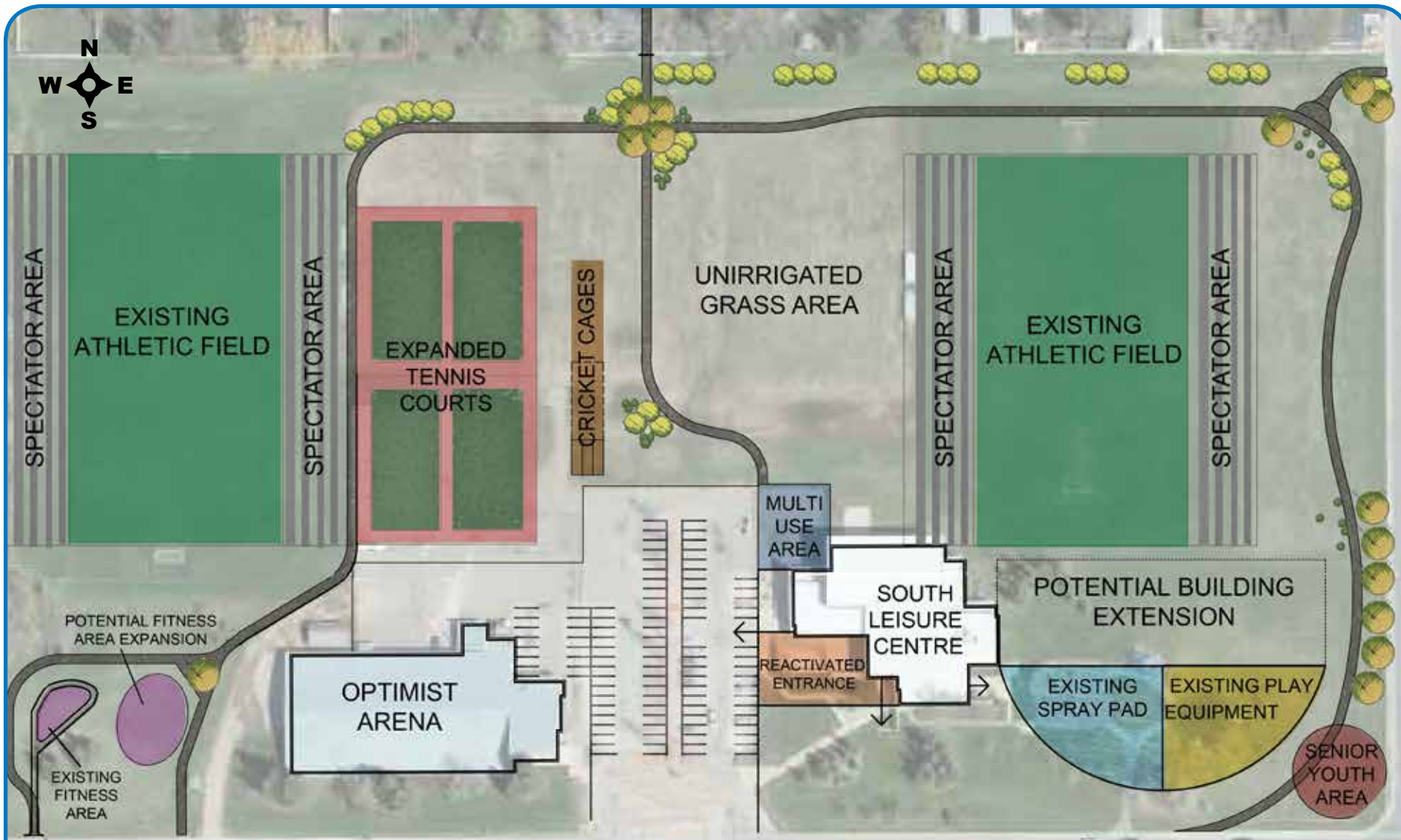

Description of Realtors Park project

The Albert Park Community Association (APCA), in partnership with the City of Regina is raising funds to improve the facilities and landscaping at Realtors Park, the area surrounding the Optimist Arena and South Leisure Centre on Sunset Drive.

This conceptual plan was developed by the City of Regina with the help of the community. The design includes development of a multi-season path around the perimeter of the park. Improved landscaping and seating will enhance the existing athletic fields, tennis courts and splash pad. The plan envisions a new multi-use grass area, and new areas for cricket, outdoor fitness, and expanded tennis courts. It is also intended to facilitate multi-generational recreation with space that could include youth activity and outdoor chess and table tennis as part of a reactivated entrance.

The design is consistent with the core values and community needs established by the community engagement process. These values include accessibility, activities for all ages, fitness and health, and traditional park space.
